



TURN UP THE

Add warmth to your bathroom with fires, tiles and toasty towel bars. It's the hot thing to do.

eattle resident Amely Wurmbrand is redoing her bathroom, and one thing is clear: it's getting a radiant-heated floor.

"They are absolutely a necessity now," says Wurmbrand, who works as an interior designer. It's not just floors. Everything from heated towel warmers to toilet seats to fireplaces are showing up in bathrooms.

"There is so much time spent in the bathroom," says do-it-yourself home improvement expert Barbara Kavovit, whose new book, "Invest in Your Nest" (Rodale Books, 2006), has an entire chapter on enhancing the bathroom. "It's where you get ready for a date, where you bathe the kids, where you relax. Plus, the more bathrooms you have, and the better they are, the more value your home has."

The bathroom must be comfortable – after all, it's the place where lots of people think or read. Historically, playwright Edmond Rostand wrote much of "Cyrano de Bergerac" in the bathroom. President Lyndon B. Johnson ordered assistants to stand by and take dictation as he performed his toilet routine. And The Fonz motioned towards the men's room when he invited visitors to "step into my office" on Happy Days.

HGTV recently launched a new weekly series, I Want That! Baths, which focuses on everything from flat-panel TVs embedded in bathroom mirrors to diamond-encrusted basins that put the "bling" in the bathroom.

So it makes sense that some of the following hot trends are taking off.

• Heated floors. Heated floors can provide the main source of heat in a home, a concept in use since ancient times; the Romans

used heated floors in bathhouses. They work through a hydronic floor-heating system that warms the floors with hot water running through tubes beneath it. You'll pay a lot to install such a system, which can include the tubes embedded in concrete, a boiler to heat the water and controls to manage the temperature. In the long run, this type of heated flooring is cheaper to run than electric floor heating, which is less expensive to install but costs more to operate. Save money by just putting a strip in front of the vanity, or outside the shower. Systems cost about \$500 for a standard bathroom, measuring nine and a half feet by six feet, without installation.

• Towel warmers. These are like racks that heat up. "It's kind of like having your own spa staff there to warm your towel for you," says

Jeffrey Haines, an interior designer in New Jersey. "Not only will they dry up wet towels, but they're great if you're in a humid environment because they freshen up those towels very quickly." Heated towel warmers will sell for \$55 to \$130, depending on variety. For those who want serious warmth, warming drawers commonly used in kitchens are migrating to the bath, as well.

• Fireplaces. The second most popular place to put a fireplace now is in the bathroom. "We're really seeing a lot of these," says David O'Neil, president of Renaissance Tile and Bath, Atlanta. "It can be as elaborate as a French chateau fireplace or as simple as Steamy soakers: heaters are now being imbedded into the wall of tubs, from a Craftsman fireplace.

People think, 'It's the end of the day, I'm going to have a glass of wine, sit in the tub and look at the stars.' Having the warmth of the fireplace is part of that feeling."

• Steam showers. This is a trend that's especially inspired by spas, by the idea of spending as much time in the bathroom as possible. After getting steam installed in your shower, you push a button and out comes the heat. Sometimes, essential oils can be used so that the steam joins with aromatherapy.

• Heated bathtubs. Tired of holding your back off the wall of the tub because it's still cold and the water hasn't heated it up? Now you can buy bathtubs that come with in-line heaters to prevent the cold occurrence. Since bathtubs are no longer made of cast iron, heat doesn't stay in as long. The change in technology has caused manufacturers to install more heat.

· Heated toilet seats. This one caused the most contention among our experts. Wurmbrand, for example, says she's never had a request for one and thinks they're useless. "This is just one invention I don't understand," she says. "I don't find plastic toilet seats to be uncomfortable. I think this is just one more bell and whistle."

> But O'Neil says his luxury bath store is selling them and that he swears by the one he has in his home. "It's just like the heated seats in some cars," he says. "Once you experience it, you have to have it."

· Warmer showers, faster. Delta's H2Okinetic Technology is a shower system that was

designed to control water delivery to completely envelop the bather. Its use of thermal dynamics and technology that creates larger droplets makes the entire shower warmer. Delta Faucet Company's Brizo brand also is working on a remote control shower, where a person can turn on the shower and adjust the temperature of the water from anywhere in their home so the water is the perfect temperature when they are ready to step in.

These are just some of the many hot trends, reminding us that the bathroom is the most private room in the home. "When you're in your most intimate space in your house, you want heat," says Tamra Fleming, president of Architect Your Life in Seattle. "Heat makes energy flow. It's the need for people to feel comfortable in their lives and in their homes."





77 hat do you get when you cross art with concrete? Decorative concrete... sounds oxymoronic, doesn't it?

Rarely can you pick up a slick home decorating magazine without seeing photos of beautiful rooms with gorgeous natural stone or antique brick floors. But rather than marble, granite or salvaged bricks, these floors may be... concrete.

Concrete is one of the most widely used construction materials in the world says the Portland Cement Association. Decorative concrete - defined as a substance that provides an aesthetic finish and structural capabilities in one - is made to be seen.

Most decorative concrete techniques involve changing the color and texture of a concrete surface to make it look like a more expensive material. Skilled finishers can mimic stone or tile surfaces that are hard to distinguish from the real thing. Homeowners and homebuilders have innumerable effects to choose from.

"Decorative concrete has become a strong area for us recently. It's something that's getting more attention nation wide - not Richard Smith Custom Concrete just in California and Las Vegas," said Brian Johnson from Carroll Distributing & Construction Supply Company's Lincoln office. "Contractors in Lincoln are now doing all types of decorative concrete including stamping new concrete, all types of overlays for existing concrete, acid stains, countertops and even furniture."



Because of its adaptability, concrete is suitable for all areas of the home, especially in the kitchen and bath, but also fireplaces, patios, pathways or water features. Homeowners can get ideas from the web, magazines and literature from concrete suppliers. Once you find the effect you want, hire an experienced and reputable contractor.

Decorative Concrete

"Homeowners should not attempt this type of work on their own," cautioned Johnson. "Saving money by 'doing it yourself' could end up costing double." Most decorative work ranges from \$8 to \$12 per square foot for stamped concrete and upwards of \$40 to \$80 per square foot for specialty jobs like countertops.

Patterns, styles and colors vary from job-to-job and no two jobs are identical. Homeowners should plan to do the whole job at once rather than over time because something done now will not likely match something done next year.



MAKE YOUR GARAGE WORK FOR YOU!

"What can I do about this mess?" "There's just no hope." "It's just a garage." It is embarrassing, but what can you do?" Do these quotes sound familiar? 

Installing a Flagstone Walkway

Place the stones where you think they will work best. Arrange them so the spaces between them provide a comfortable stepping distance. Adjust the stones to create gradual curves if desired. Walk the path in both directions a couple of times and make any final cdjustments.



Once the flagstones are in their permanent spots, cut into the sod around them with a sharp shovel to mark the shape. Remove two inches of soil plus the depth of the stone to make room for the base material and the stone.



Add about two inches of sand and smooth it out to make a stable but pliable base for the stone. Without sand, the pathway would be less stable and the stones would be prone to cracking.



Place the flagstone into the layer of sand or other base material and gradually twist the stone into place. Stones should not rock or teeter.



Check to make sure the stones are level to the ground. If they aren't, adjust the sand and stone accordingly.



Lay a 2x4 board across the surface of the flagstone and tap the board with a rubber mallet to seat the flagstone firmly in place. Double check the level of the stones.



Fill the area in between the stones with mulch, gravel or sand. Sweep the filler material into all of the gaps. Thoroughly water the pathway to wash the stones and help them and the material settle.



Sit back, relax and enjoy the functional beauty that a flagstone walkway provides.

Use Your Style to Fill that Empty Room

By KIT DAVEY

If you've just bought a larger home, added on to your house, or are redecorating an existing space, you're faced with the exciting yet daunting challenge of filling an empty room. With patience and a little planning, you can avoid costly design errors and

comfortably furnish your room in a way that reflects your personal style.

Follow these suggested steps to creating a functional, comfortable and appealing room:

• Define the room's function. How are you going to use the space? List all the possible functions of the room. Typical activities in a living room might include entertaining, reading, listening to music or watching TV. You also might want to display collections. A family room might have all of these functions

plus toy storage and a study or work area. A large master suite now might be a place to meditate, do paperwork or watch TV.

- Determine your furniture requirements. Once you know exactly how you'll use the room, list the pieces of furniture you'll need to perform those activities. Be flexible and creative. If you seldom entertain, there's no point in spending a ton of money on seating for 10 in your living room. Why not create a cozy conversation area consisting of a love seat and a pair of chairs, and plan on bringing in dining room chairs on those rare evenings you have a house full of guests? If you plan to watch TV in the room, consider an armoire or modular entertainment center, which also can store hobby materials or toys. In a bedroom with insufficient storage you might use a dresser instead of a nightstand. Jot down specific pieces of furniture next to each of the functions.
- Make a floor plan. Carefully measure the dimensions of the room, noting doors, outlets, window widths, etc., and create a scale drawing of the room. Make several copies of the room plan to experiment with. Next, make scale drawings of each piece of furniture on your list, estimating

their sizes or using furniture you already own as size guides.

Cut out the furniture shapes and begin arranging the furniture on your plan. Try every option, even the outlandish ones. Consider where lighting



will go and functionality: Is there a place to put a table lamp? Does everyone have a place to put his/her drink? Can you reach the bookcase from the desk? Let your friends and family try, too. You may come up with several arrangements that work well, or you might have to delete or add furniture. In any case, sketch out at least two possible plans.

- Mock it up. This is a crucial step! You can save yourself thousands of dollars and be saved from years of forcing yourself to live with the wrong furniture if you take the time to do this. Armed with your possible floor plans, return to your empty room and do your best to recreate the plans in three dimensions. Drag in furniture from the other rooms or position stacks of cardboard boxes to see how things will look. Make adjustments or try completely new possibilities until you get an arrangement that feels visually balanced and which you know will serve all the functions you want. Make a final floor plan based on this exercise. If you have hardwood floors and plan on purchasing area rugs, lay newspapers on the floor to determine the best size, given your final plan.
- Define your message. How do you want to feel in this room? Enlivened, relaxed, playful,

thoughtful, friendly? What words describe what you'd like the room to say? Airy, sophisticated, fun, natural, sunny, dramatic, intelligent, simple? Write down all the adjectives, feelings, and thoughts that you'd like to be present in the room. Spend time going through catalogs, home magazines and books collecting images of rooms that show some or all of the concept you want the room to communicate.

- Select a predominant style or theme. A visually peaceful room tends to have furnishings that are in the same style, such as country, contemporary, Victorian, etc., so you might select a style or theme which best reflects how you want to feel in the room. It's possible to create harmony with an eclectic mix of furniture, just as long as you stay true to your clearly defined message. I have a friend who has a wild array of furnishings in her home, but it all works because everything in it uniquely conveys her personal style: "whimsical, playful, clever and love of dinosaurs."
- Select a color scheme. It's easier and more restful to the eye to focus on one, two or three

- colors, plus neutrals. Open your closet and take a look at the colors you love to wear. Do any of these colors fit in with the concept you have for the room? Create visual peace and cohesion by clearly defining which colors will predominate and plan to carefully place them around the room.
- Incorporate existing possessions. Go on a treasure hunt in your home. Is there anything you already own that would work in the new space? Do you have a family heirloom or special gift you want to incorporate? Put these items in the room now, and take pictures of them. When you're out shopping you can refer to the photos.
- Build the room around something you love. I suggest doing lots of research and window-shopping before committing to any major pieces of furniture. When you least expect it, you'll run into the perfect chair, sculpture piece or striped fabric that expresses exactly what you want the room to communicate. Build the room around this object. Once you're committed to something that makes your heart sing, it's easy to make other decisions and purchases.




